HAWAIIAN CHICKEN SKEWERS

DIFFICULTY: ★ ★ ★ ★

DRINK  SMART®

NUMBER OF SERVINGS: 8 SKEWERS

PREP TIME: CHICKEN MARINADE: 10 MINUTES | PINEAPPLE BBQ SAUCE: 3 MINUTES

COOK TIME: 5-7 MINUTES

TOOLS & UTENSILS: GRILL, RUBBER SPATULA, SMALL BOWL, CHEF'S KNIFE, CUTTING BOARD, STURDY WOODEN SKEWERS, TONGS

CHICKEN MARINADE

YIELD: 1 CUP

INGREDIENTS

- ½ **Cup** Pineapple Juice
- ¼ **Cup** Oil, Vegetable or Canola
- ½ **tsp.** Cumin, ground
- ¼ **Bunch** Cilantro
- 1 **Tbsp.** Garlic, chopped
- 1 **tsp.** Salt, kosher
- ½ **tsp.** Black Pepper, ground
- 8 **Each** Chicken Thighs, boneless, skinless

PROCEDURE

- Combine all ingredients other than cilantro and chicken into a freezer bag or container, mix well.
- Add chicken and cilantro. Keep in marinade for 2 hours or overnight for maximum flavor.

PINEAPPLE BBQ SAUCE

YIELD: APPROX. 1 CUP

INGREDIENTS

- 1 **Cup** Sweet Baby Ray's BBQ Sauce
- ¼ **Cup** Pineapple, rough chopped (Tidbits)
- 1 **tsp.** Sriracha

PROCEDURE

- Mix all ingredients together in mixing bowl with rubber spatula.
- Reserve covered under refrigeration until use.

HAWAIIAN CHICKEN SKEWERS

YIELD: APPROX. 8 EACH

INGREDIENTS

- 1 **Recipe** Marinated Chicken Thighs
- 16 **Each** Red Onion Petals, 1.5" x 1.5" (1-2 Onions depending on size)
- 16 **Each** Pineapple Cubes, 1" x 1" (1-2 Pineapples depending on size)
- 8 **Each** Wooden Skewers, 10-12", soaked in water
- 1 **Recipe** Pineapple BBQ Sauce

PROCEDURE

- Remove chicken thighs from marinade. Cut each chicken thigh in half, yielding 16 pieces.
- Place one red onion petal onto skewer. Add one pineapple cube. Next add one piece of chicken, going lengthwise so its spreads out for better cooking. Add another round of red onion, pineapple, and chicken.
- Build the rest of the skewers in the same fashion.
- Place skewers on hot grill, rotating occasionally to avoid burning, until chicken reaches an internal temperature of 165°F. For added flavor, brush on the Pineapple BBQ Sauce throughout the cooking process.
- Serve with Pineapple BBQ Sauce. ENJOY!!!!
