



I'M GOING TO A BRAVES GAME!





I will park in a parking deck or parking lot. I will then either walk or take a shuttle to the ballpark.


There will be a lot of sights, smells and sounds as I go towards the ballpark.

The metal detectors are to keep me safe.








I will get to my seat using the escalator, elevator, stairs or a ramp.


This is what my seat will look like.

There will be music and a lot of cheering!









If I get hungry, I can get food from a concession stand. I may have to wait in line.








If the Braves hit a home run, there might be loud fireworks! I will see the Heavy Hitters drumline walking around the ballpark.


It's okay to cover my ears or wear headphones.




There will be fun activities during the game, like The Home Depot tool race and RaceTrac's Beat the Freeze!

I can go to Hope and Will's Sandlot, where there are carnival games, a zip line, a climbing wall and more.










When it is time to go home, I will exit through the gate I entered in and go back to the car.
