The Chick-Fil-A cow weighs 18,000 pounds and stands 40 feet tall.

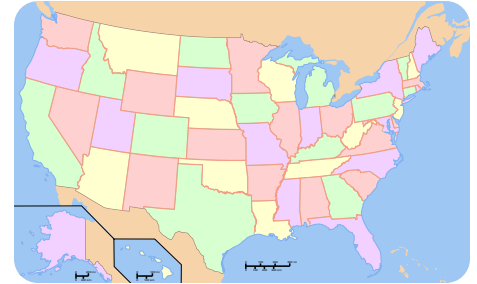
1. The average car weighs about 4,500 pounds. How many cars would it take to match the cow's weight?

2. How many 4' tall cows would you need to equal the height of the Chick-Fil-A cow?

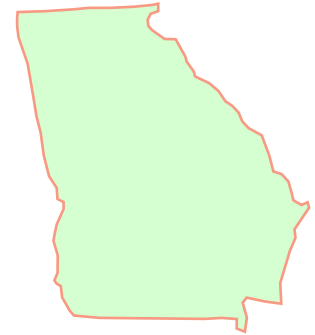

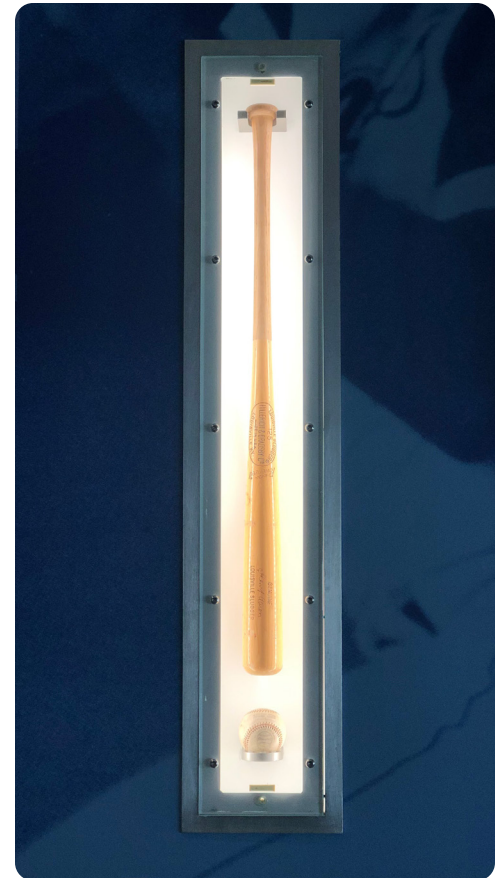
