ENTRY PROCEDURES

- All registered visitors to Dodger Stadium must enter through **Gate A** at the corner of Vin Scully Avenue and Stadium Way (off of Sunset Boulevard).
Only approved guests will be permitted on Dodger Stadium property.
- Please arrive early, as you will be asked to undergo a brief screening process. Be prepared to:

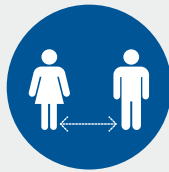

- Wear a face covering, which is required for employees and guests at all times at Dodger Stadium. If you have a health condition that prevents you from wearing a face covering or other concerns with this policy, please reach out to your Dodger contact.
- Observe distancing, and maintain at least six feet between yourself and others.
- Utilize hand sanitizing stations and wash your hands frequently.
- For your safety, only use restrooms on Levels 5 & 8 as well as the Dugout Club. To focus cleaning efforts, these are the only facilities that are being cleaned and sanitized regularly.
