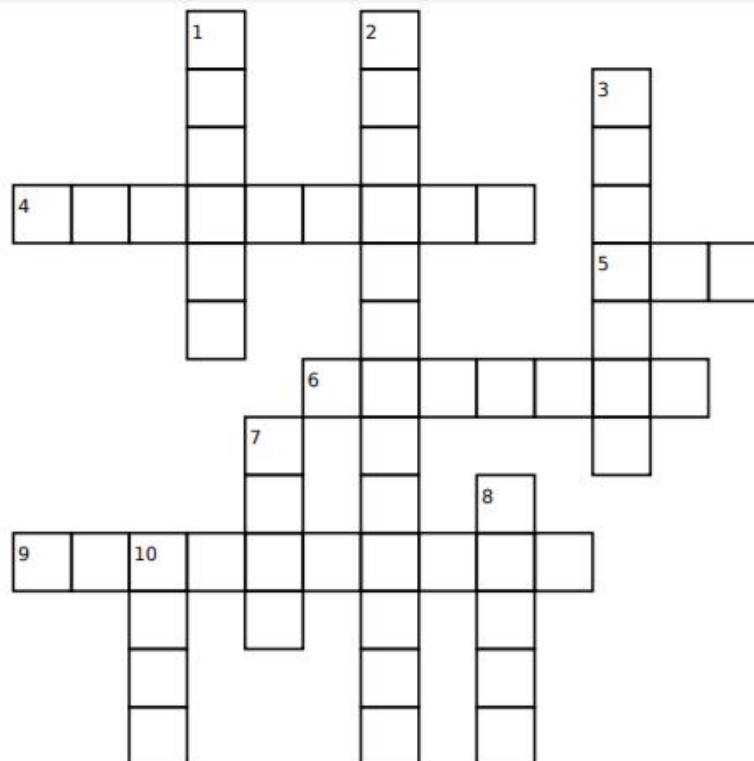


CROSSWORD



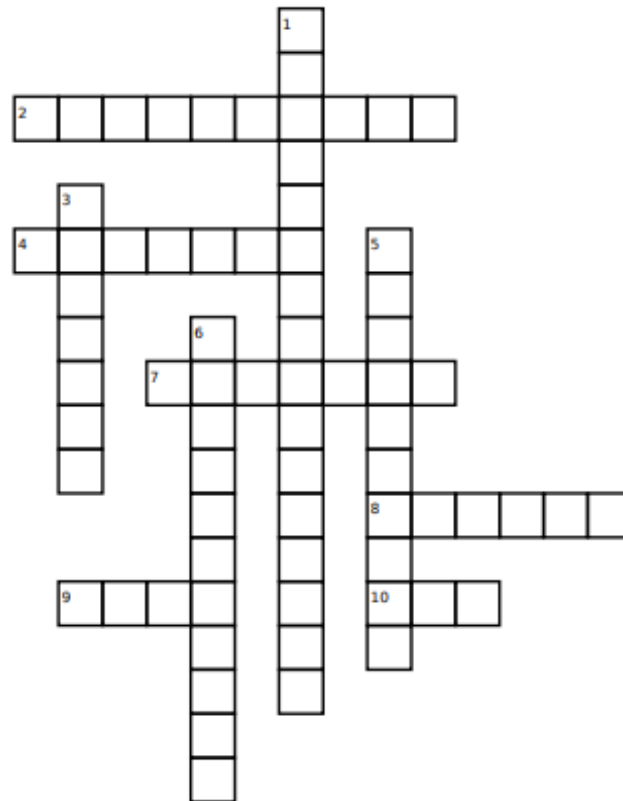
Down:

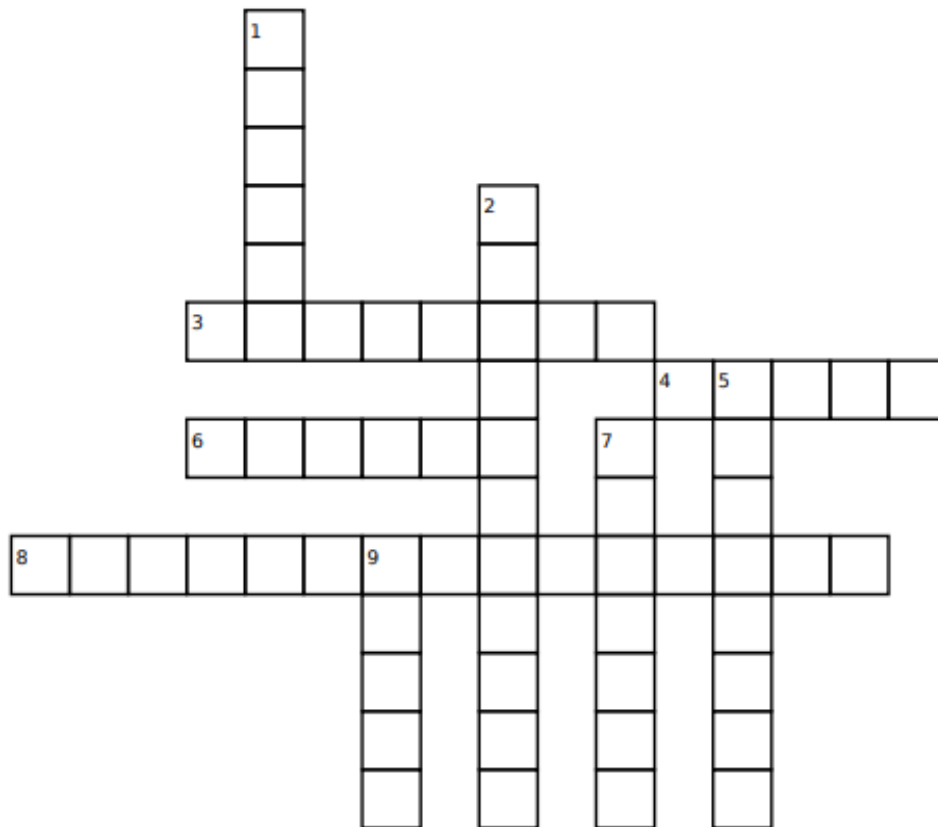
Down:

9. This is used by pitchers, basemen, catchers, and outfielders to catch the ball

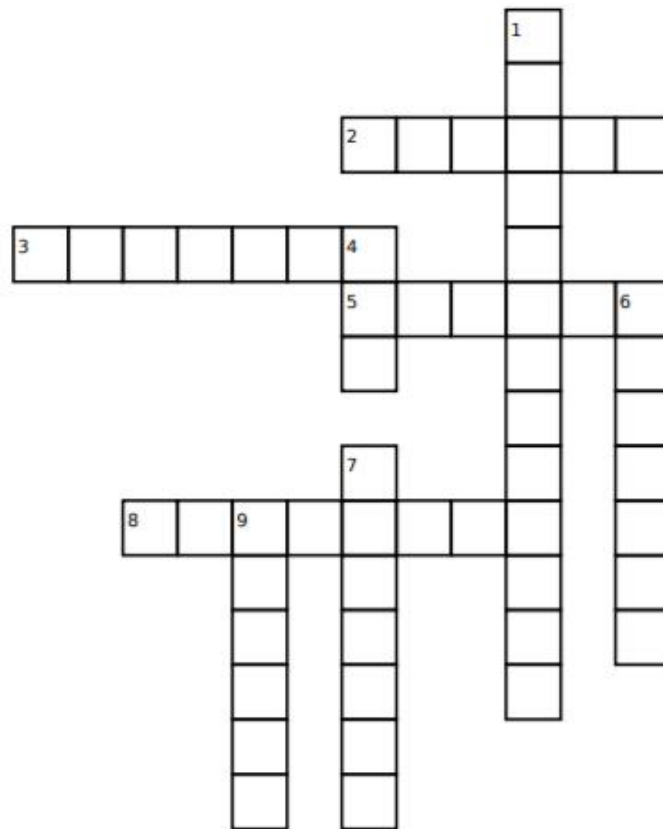
Across:

9. Division Padres play in

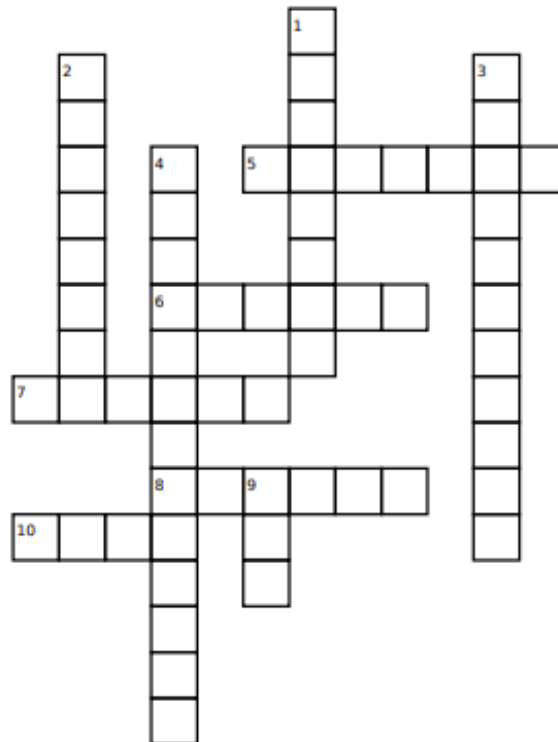
Across:
