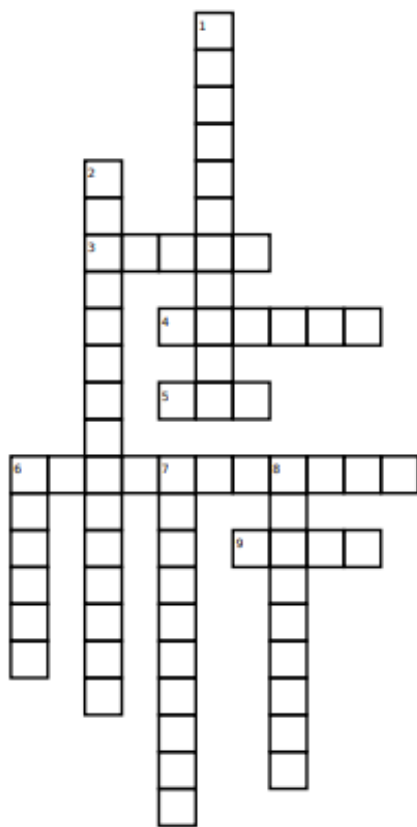

## CROSSWORD



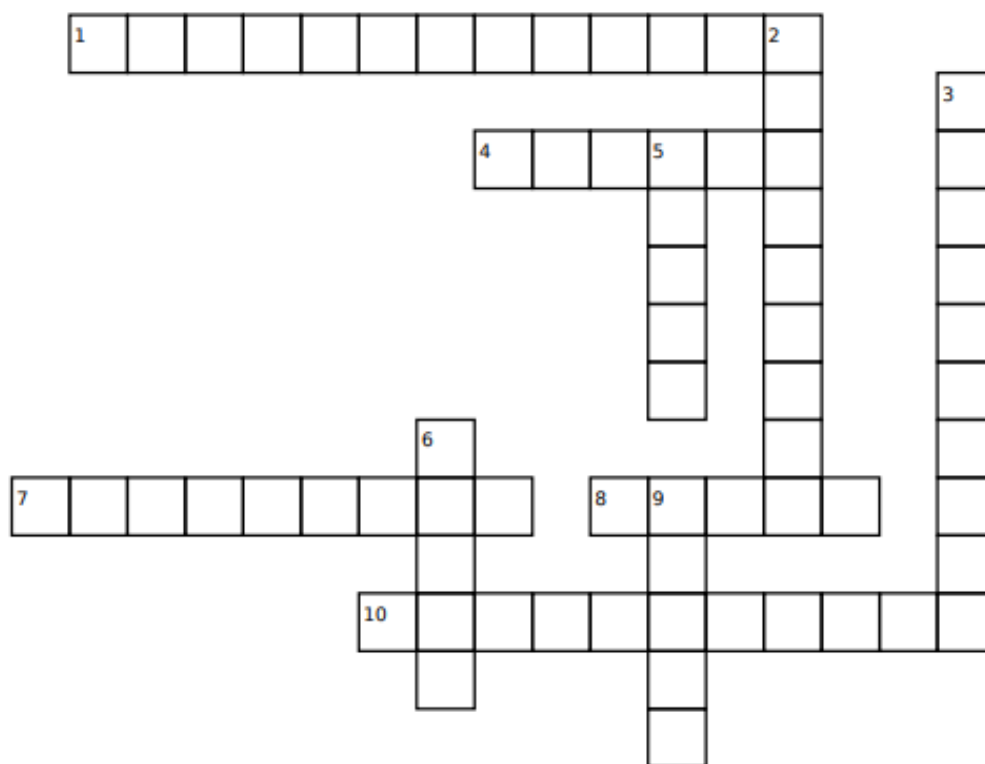
### Down:

9. This term refers to when the batting team records several hits in a single inning that result in more than one run

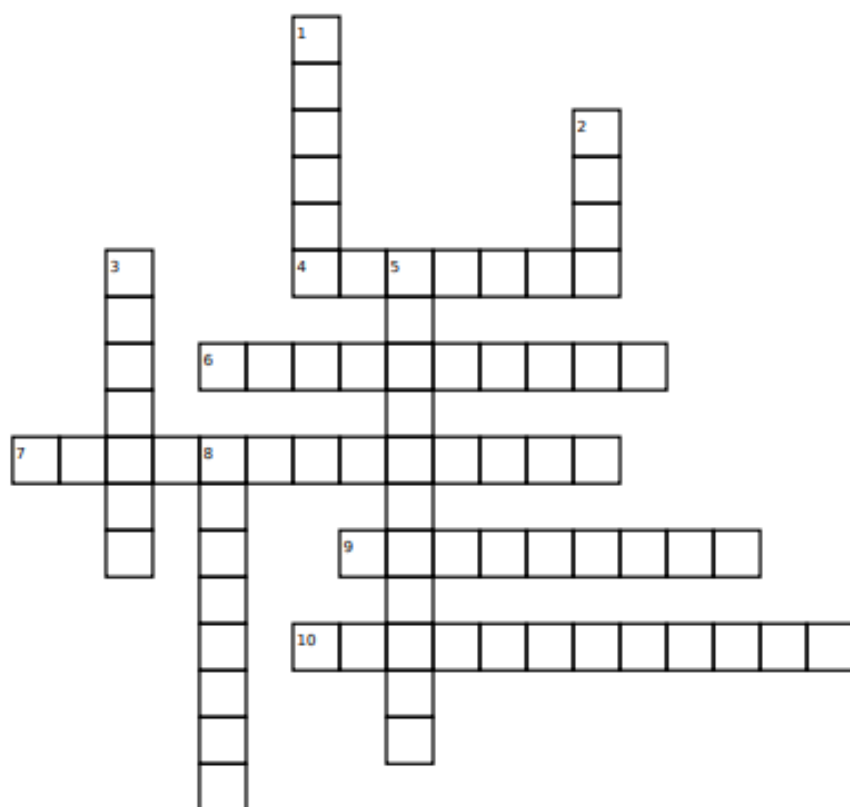
**Across:**

8. This term refers to a pitcher who enters the game after the starting pitcher is removed

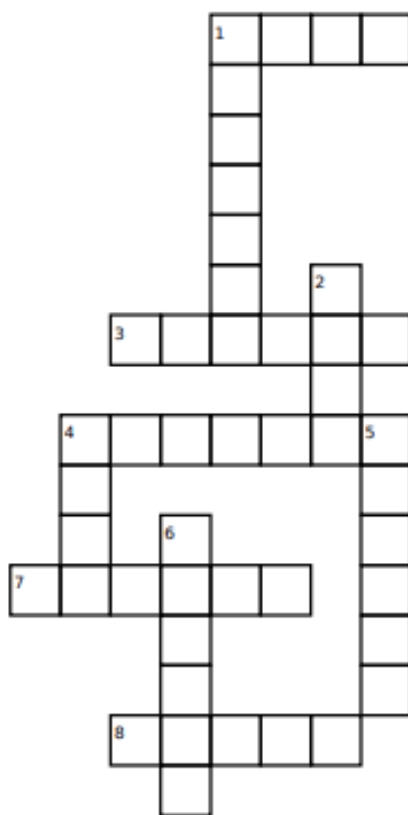
### Across:
