



Calvin, the giant tortoise; and Iggy, the land iguana.




Growing up on the Galapagos Islands, the Phanatic spent so much time with his pals that the other animals gave the group the name, the Galapagos Gang.

birthday party," she thought to herself.




The next day, Phoebe placed a birthday invitation in a box with some other special surprises and mailed it to the Galapagos Islands.

"Now I have something to wear!" she said.




Sid said, "Iggy, there's even something special here for you."

The gang packed their bags, hopped onto their special boat and set sail for America. "Philadelphia, here we come!" Calvin announced.






Sid opened up his map. "We're not in Philadelphia yet. We're in California and Philadelphia is 3,000 miles away," he said.

When they arrived in San Francisco, they rode on an old cable car up and down the steep hills in the city.




They made their way to Arizona and sailed over the Grand Canyon on hang gliders.




Calvin looked down and said, "That's bigger than the hole I dug on the beach last week!"


In Oklahoma, they pretended that they were real cowboys riding their horses in the Old West. "Ride 'em, cowboy!" they all shouted.




What an adventure it was! They travelled by train...




... planes...

They cruised under the Arch in St. Louis...




and held on tight as they splashed their way down
