

"If it means getting warmed up, count me in!" Lefty joked.





Everyone cheered as the sun disappeared into the water.









Spring training is a time for the Phanatic to get ready for the regular season. He got into shape by running up and down the aisles, getting the crowd to cheer louder and louder.




He made some of the Phillies fans feel like they were home by delivering cheesesteaks to their seats.



The Phanatic dressed up in a new pirate's costume that he had made just for spring training. The crowd laughed when "Green Beard Phanatic" danced with the third base umpire.




