WHAT YOU NEED

- 2 Players
- Glue or tape
- Scissors
- 1 Writing Utensil
- 2 Dice
(template on the following page)
- 4 Away Team Player Markers
(template below)
- 4 Home Team Player Markers
(template below)

HOW TO PLAY

Find a partner to play with. Both players roll one die; the player who rolls the highest number gets to choose between playing as the home team or the away team.

The away team bats first. To bat, the away team will roll both dice. Add the two numbers together and use the batting chart below to determine the outcome.

Place the away team marker on the bases accordingly. For example, if you hit a triple, move the marker to 3rd base.

When there are runners on base, the runners can move around the bases according to the new batter's outcome. For example, if your team has a player on 2nd base, and the batter hits a single, the runner on second may move up one base. Or if you have a runner on 2nd base and the batter hits a double, then the runner on 2nd may move 2 bases to score.

Once a team rolls 3 outs, their turn is over and the other team takes their turn. Each turn is half of an inning. After each turn, record the score in the appropriate inning.

BATTING CHART

When your team is up to bat, roll both dice and add up the two numbers. Refer to this chart to find out how the batter did!
