**TONIGHT:** The Rockies will play the second game of this 3-game series against the Padres at Coors Field...this series against the San Diego marks the final series in the Rockies current nine-game, 10-day homestand...Colorado is now 3-4 on this homestand following last night's 7-1 loss...the Rockies lost the first series of this homestand 1-game-2 against San Francisco, then won the last series 2-games-1 against Arizona...following this series, the Rockies will take to the road for a six-game, six-day roadtrip to Milwaukee (4/20-22) and Pittsburgh (4/23-25), bookended by off-days on 4/19 and 4/26.

- Rockies left-handed pitcher Jamie Moyer will make his third start of 2012 tonight...Moyer tossed a season-high 5.2 innings, allowing just 2 earned runs, 4 runs total, in his last start on 4/12 vs. SF...he is still looking for his first victory in a Rockies uniform.
- Moyer will face Padres right-handed pitcher Anthony Bass...the Michigan native is making his fourth appearance/second start of the season tonight...in his first start, Bass allowed just one run in 4.1 innings in the Padres loss on 4/12 vs. ARI.

**VS. SAN DIEGO:** The Rockies dropped their fifth-straight game to the Padres last night, dating back to 9/4/11 at SD...Colorado has not defeated the Padres since 9/3/11 at SD...last night's loss was also the fourth straight defeat to San Diego at Coors Field, as the Padres swept a 3-game set at Coors Field 9/19-21/11...despite the current streaks, Colorado holds the all-time edge over the Padres with a 158-146 overall record and an 80-71 record at home, including 74-67 at Coors Field...Colorado has held a .500 record or better against San Diego in each of the last six seasons, since 2006.

**WHERE HE STANDS:** Tonight's starter Jamie Moyer has already been mentioned in several Major League all-time marks for making starts at age 49...Moyer, who is 49-years, 150-days-old today set a Major League record in his last start by becoming the oldest pitcher to make multiple starts in the same season...he is also the second-oldest pitcher ever to make a Major League start (Satchel Paige - 59-years, 80-days on 9/25/1965 for KC)...if he is able to win a game this season, Moyer will become the oldest pitcher in Major League history to earn a victory.

- In addition to the age records, Moyer comes into tonight start 35th on the MLB all-time wins list with 267 victories...Moyer needs one win to tie Hall-of-Famer Jim Palmer for 34th on the all-time list at 268 wins.
- Moyer also enters tonight's start 37th on the MLB all-time strikeouts list with 2,410...Moyer needs six strikeouts to tie Luis Tiant for 36th on the all-time list.
- Additionally, Moyer is 39th on the MLB all-time innings pitched list with 4,031.0 ip...he is one of only 39 pitchers in the history of Major League Baseball to toss at least 4,000.0 innings.

**DOUBLE DOWN:** Despite the Rockies having just seven hits last night, the club's lone extra-base hit was a double from Michael Cuddyer...the double was already Cuddyer's sixth of the season, which moves him back into a tie for the most doubles in the Majors this season...the double was also Cuddyer's eighth extra-base hit, which is tied for the second most in the National League.

**2012 DRAFT UPDATE:** Today, Major League Baseball released the official draft order for all 40 rounds and the two compensation rounds...the Rockies have five selections prior to the fourth round...the Rockies select 10th overall, then have the 46th selection in the draft for compensation from Mark Ellis signing with Los Angeles...the Rockies then have their second (73rd overall) and third (105th overall) round choices before selecting with the final pick (128th overall) of Compensation Round B for not signing Peter O'Brien in the 2011 draft...the Rockies will select 10th in each round from 4-40...the draft will begin on Monday, June 4th at 5:00 p.m. MDT from MLB Network's Studio 42 in Secaucus, NJ.

### 2012 RUN SUPPORT

Jamie Moyer will make his third start of the season tonight, and also his third start as a Rockie...today will be Moyer's 689th career game/631st career start.

- **Last Start:** Allowed just 2 earned runs, 4 runs total, on 8 hits and one walk, with 3 strikeouts...Moyer took his second-straight loss despite being the only Rockies pitcher to toss at least 5.0 innings in consecutive starts this season...was supported by 0 runs for the second straight start.
- **vs. the Padres:** In his last start against the Padres on 6/5/10 vs. SD in Philadelphia, Moyer tossed a complete game for a victory...in that start he allowed just 2 runs on 7 hits...Moyer is 4-2 in his last 6 starts vs. SD.
- **Win at 49:** If Moyer is able to win one game for the Rockies this season he will become the oldest pitcher in Major League history to register a victory...the current record holder is Jack Quinn, who was 49 years, 70 days old when he won his last game on 9/13/32 for the Dodgers (Elias).
- **Had to Earn it:** After signing with Colorado this winter as a Minor League free agent with a Major League camp invite, Moyer earned his way onto the Rockies Opening Day roster by going 2-1 with a 2.50 ERA (18.0 ip, 5 er) with 4 walks and 16 strikeouts over five games/four starts.
- **Uniform Facts:** With his first start as a Rockie 4/7 at HOU, Moyer has now started a game with eight different teams: Chicago Cubs (1986-88), Texas (1989-90), St. Louis (1991), Baltimore (1993-95), Boston (1996), Seattle (1996-06), Philadelphia (2006-10) and Colorado (2012).
- **Opening Day:** By being a member of the Rockies Opening Day roster as a starting pitcher, Moyer has become the oldest starting pitcher to make an Opening Day roster in Major League history (40 years, 140 days old)...only two players have made Opening Day rosters at an older age than Moyer, and both were relievers; Hoyt Wilhelm (49 years, 350 days) in 1972 with the Dodgers and Jack Quinn (49 years, 310 days) in 1933 with the Reds (Elias).
- **Satchel's Start:** After Moyer's first pitch of the season, the only pitcher in Major League history that has been older and made a Major League start is Satchel Paige, who was 59 years, 80 days old when he started for Kansas City 9/25/1965 (Elias).
- **49 Club:** With his start 4/7 at HOU, Jamie became the fifth player since 1965 to appear in a Major League game at age 49 or older...the last player to appear in a MLB game at 49 was Julio Franco at 49 years, 25 days on 9/17/07 for ATL vs. FLA...Moyer is 49 years, 146 days old today...he will be the oldest player to appear in a game since Minnie Minoso (54 years, 311 days) on 10/5/80 for the White Sox vs. California, and the oldest pitcher to appear in a game since Hoyt Wilhelm (49 years, 350 days) on 7/10/72 for the Dodgers vs. Philadelphia (Elias).
- **Comeback Trail:** Moyer sat out the entire 2011 season while rehabbing his surgically repaired ulnar collateral ligament in his left elbow (Tommy John surgery)...Moyer went 9-9 with a 4.84 ERA (111.2 ip, 60 er) in 19 games/starts for the Phillies in 2010.
- **Where he Stands:** Moyer ranks 16th on the MLB all-time games started (630) list and 39th on the MLB all-time innings pitched list (4031.0)...he needs 17 starts to tie Tom Seaver for 15th on the games started list and 56.2 innings to tie Red Faber for 38th on the innings list...Moyer's 267 career victories are also one win shy of tying Jim Palmer for 34th on the MLB all-time wins list...he leads all active Major Leaguers in victories, starts, innings pitched, strikeouts (2,410).

- **vs. the Padres:** Tomorrow will mark Nicasio's third career start against the Padres...in his two career starts, both coming in 2011, Nicasio is 1-0 with a 2.08 ERA (13.0 ip, 3 er), three walks and 19 strikeouts...in his sole start at Coors Field, Nicasio went 6.0 innings, allowing two runs on six hits and one walk while striking out nine in the win.
- **Cool at Coors:** Nicasio will be making his ninth career start at Coors Field...he is 4-1 with a 3.09 ERA (43.2 ip, 15 er) with 12 walks to 31 strikeouts in his eight starts at Coors...Nicasio's sole loss at Coors Field came in the game that he was hit in the head by a batted ball in the second inning, 8/5/11 vs. WAS...the Rockies are 7-1 in his starts at Coors Field
- **Strikeout to Walks:** Through 15 career MLB starts, Nicasio owns a 2.70 strikeout to walk ratio with 65 strikeouts compared to just 24 walks...Nicasio has walked more than 3 batters in just one of his 15 career starts...Nicasio also has at least four strikeouts in all but four of his starts in his career.
