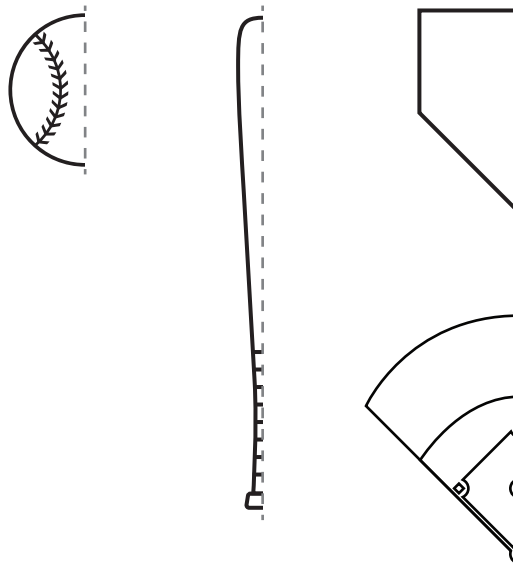
- _____ A baserunner who is required to run and is not able to make it to the next base safely.

DID YOU KNOW?

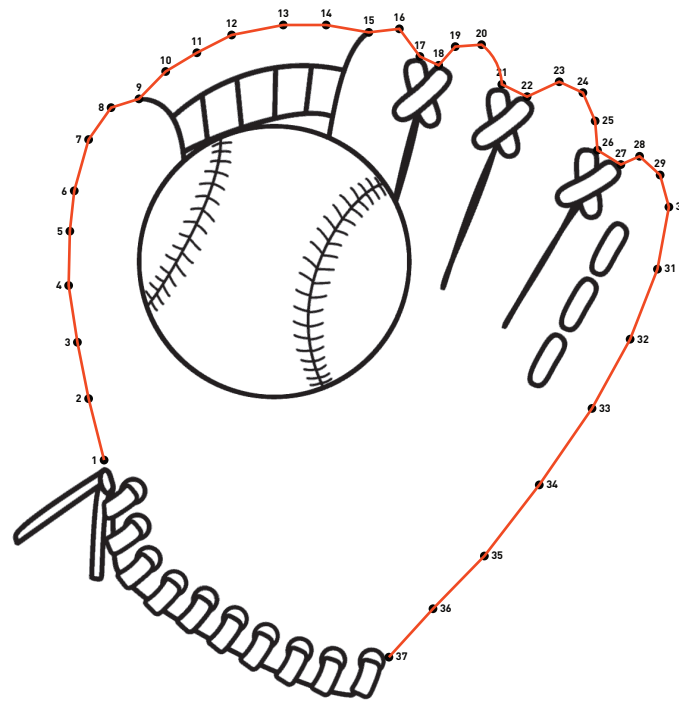
Tigers are a keystone species. They're integral to the health of the ecosystems in which they live. As apex predators, they keep prey species under control.
