RESERVED TAILGATE SPACE

WHAT TIME CAN YOU ENTER THE TAILGATE AREA?

Enter the parking lot 3 hours before the scheduled game start time*. Must arrive no later than 2 hours prior to game time to access your reserved tailgate space

WHAT AREA IS RESERVED WITH THE PURCHASE?

The assigned parking space associated with your Reserved Tailgate Space and the adjacent sidewalk.

CAN YOU PURCHASE ADDITIONAL PARKING SPACES?

Additional parking passes can be purchased for the standard pre-paid parking lots. Any additional parking will be in a different lot than the Reserved Tailgate Spaces.

HOW DO YOU GET TO THE RESERVED TAILGATE PARKING AREA?

Enter Lot E from Princeton and 37th Street.

WHAT ARE THE GUIDELINES FOR RESERVED TAILGATE SPACE?

- 10 x 10 tents are allowed per Reserved Tailgate Space.
- One small grill per space (not to exceed 20-pound propane tanks)
 - All charcoal must be dumped in the coal bins provided. Coal bins are located in the tailgate pad.
 - For extra safety, please bring a gallon of water to extinguish your coal after cooking. For your convenience, metal containers are provided for coal disposal. Please keep grills a safe distance from vehicles, and never put hot coal under your car.
- Kegs are not permitted on Chicago White Sox property, in the parking lots or in the adjacent areas.
- Gray wire trash baskets are provided for your refuse.
- Free standing speakers, live bands, DJs, or excessively loud music are not permitted.
- Please keep our neighborhood neat and respect your neighbors and ours.
- Please note there is no tailgating permitted following the conclusion of the game.
- Parking is allowed in marked spaces only.
- Vehicles parked unlawfully will be towed immediately.
- No selling or soliciting is allowed on Chicago White Sox property.
- Vehicles with advertising or signage are prohibited.
- Please note there is no tailgating permitted following the conclusion of the game. All parking lots close approximately one hour after the game.
